## President's Message

Have you ever been to the Bellagio resort in Las Vegas? Just beyond the Chihuly glass-flowered ceiling lobby, they decorate a solarium in the most exotic ways imaginable; it is absolutely a delight for the eye. The theme this time celebrated the Chinese "Year of the Rabbit." Red lanterns hung over oversized moss-covered rabbits, and red sails reflected in shimmering lily ponds populated by goldfish. ## EVAA Workshops

**Mar 26, 2011 "Colored Pencil Free and Fast" presented by Rose Moon.** It is a class open to beginner artists, beginner colored pencil users, accomplished artists and experienced colored pencil artists who want to learn this new technique.

We will use waxed based Prismacolor pencils and a framing board called Museum Board. The board will be supplied and students will bring their own pencils. Rose will have a few pencils to loan as well.

Hopefully some students will become interested in using pencils as they are a non toxic and very forgiving media. They are great for slowing people down and for learning to see contrast and color that often gets missed when moving too fast.
